Pre-Enrollment Information

Applicants interested in pursuing a career in barbering or a related field should consider all aspects of such a decision.

Persons who want to become a barber must:

1. Have finger dexterity and a sense of form and artistry.
2. Enjoy dealing with the public and be able to follow client directions.
3. Keep abreast of the latest fashions and barbering techniques.
4. Work long hours while building a personal clientele in order to make the desired income.
5. Make a strong commitment to the educational process and complete the program.
6. Learn business skills applicable to the desired position.
7. You may have to make a personal investment for advertising and promotions such as the printing of business cards or cooperative advertising.

In addition, prospective students should be aware that:

1. Barbers usually work in clean, pleasant surroundings with good lighting and ventilation. Good health and stamina are important, because the work can be arduous and physically demanding due to the long hours standing with hands at shoulder level for most of their shift.
2. Barbers are expected to maintain clean work areas and sanitize all work implements for effective and successful performance with the industry. There will be exposure to various chemicals and fumes that may cause irritation or allergic reactions. Special care is taken to use protective clothing, such as plastic gloves or aprons.
3. Methods of compensation may vary and may include straight salary, salary plus commissions, straight commission, sliding scale commission, retail commission or independent contracting (renting space and equipment from an existing salon). A number of factors can determine the total income of barbers, including the size and location of the salon, the number of hours worked, clients' tipping habits, and competition from other barbershops. Barber's initiative and ability to attract and hold regular clients are key factors in determining his or her earnings.
4. According to The Barber, Cosmetology, Esthetics, and Nail Technology Act of 1985, it is unlawful for any person to practice, or to hold himself or herself out to be a barber without a license issued by the Illinois Department of Professional Regulation. A person must attend a school of Barbering approved by the Department and complete a total of 1500 hours in the study of Barbering. After which the individual has to pass an examination conducted by the Department, or its designated testing service with a minimum score of 75%, to determine fitness to receive a license as a Barber.
